## 1. Location

#### EduCity, Turku School of Applied Sciences

Joukahaisenkatu 7, 20520 Turku

This venue is located near Kupittaa Train Station and can be reached easily by foot or public transport from the centre of the city. You can walk to EduCity from the city centre, which takes around 30 minutes from the *Market Square* or *Kauppatori* circled in red on the left. We recommend walking past the *Turku Cathedral* or *Tuomiokirkko*.








The following modes of transport are connected to the venue:

- Bus: Line 60 in the direction of Varissuo until Urheiluhalli stop, 32 in the direction of Varissuo until Kupittaan asema stop, 221 in the direction of Skanssi-Kaarina until Urheiluhalli stop. You can look up the schedule from Market Square Turku to EduCity using <u>Föli's journey planner</u>.

#### Lähipysäkkien aikataulut (foli.fi)






## 2. Introduction

SCALE-UP is an EU-funded Innovation Action (IA), spanning over 4 years (2021-2025) across 3 European Urban Nodes (Antwerp, Madrid, Turku). In total, 28 innovative mobility measures are tested across the nodes to prepare the cities for a green, resilient and inclusive future.

What differentiates SCALE-UP from other projects is that the consortium invests in infrastructures, travel modes and deployments which are meant to last much beyond the duration of the project. Citizens can profit from the project activities for years to come.

The diversity of the consortium is our biggest asset: to overcome each Urban Node's biggest barrier, they can rely on the experience and feedback from the other Urban Nodes in an interactive and intensive knowledge transfer. Antwerp, Madrid and Turku each excel in several domains of urban mobility and can share datadriven heuristics with each other.

## 5. Practical info

## Arriving to Turku

You have made a great decision visiting Turku. Welcome! Below you can find some suggestions on how to arrive here in the most pleasant way possible.

You have three options regarding flights to Turku:

- 1. Through Helsinki with train or bus
- 2. Through Riga to Turku Airport
- 3. Through Stockholm with a connecting flight or cruise connection

## Through Helsinki with train or bus

- Bus: There are direct bus routes from Helsinki Airport to Turku. You can look up the schedule and buy tickets here: **www.matkahuolto.fi/en**.
- Train: It is also possible to take a train from Helsinki Airport to Kupittaa (Turku). You can look up the schedule and buy tickets on <u>www.vr.fi/en</u>. The train is not direct from the airport to Turku. You need to take Commuter train P to Pasila and change to another train at the Pasila station in Helsinki. Pasila has a big shopping centre called Tripla if you need to do some quick shopping.

**Note about the train!** Make the search for tickets and schedule with Helsinki Airport and Kupittaa (Turku). There are some rail works going on in Turku currently meaning that the trains from Helsinki do not go directly to the main railway station. If you select Turku as your destination, you will end up spending about 45 minutes extra on the train as the train will make a detour to a place called Toijala.





## Through Riga to Turku Airport

- Bus: You can get to the city centre from the airport on bus line 1. You can look up the routes from the journey planner here <u>www.reittiopas.foli.fi/</u> using the locations from Turku Airport to Market Square Turku. Read more about Föli on "After you get to Turku".
- Taxi: If you arrive at night and buses are not running, it is possible to book a taxi. We recommend using a company called Taxidata. You can find more information on the taxis at the airport on <u>www.finavia.fi/en/airports/turku/parking-access/taxis</u>.

# Through Stockholm with a connecting flight or a cruise connection

The connecting flight from Stockholm to Turku take 55 minutes at the shortest. If you arrive to Turku Airport, follow the instructions following "Through Riga to Turku Airport". If you arrive to Helsinki Airport, follow the instructions following "Through Helsinki with train or bus".

From Stockholm, you can book a cruise across the Baltic Sea via <u>Viking Line</u> or <u>Tallink Silja</u>. The Port of Turku is approximately 2 km from the city centre, but you can take bus number 1 towards Turku Airport if you prefer.

## After you get to Turku

#### Bus

In Turku area Föli buses are a great option for travelling. You can pay for your bus ticket on the bus using contactless payment. Make sure to use the same card or mobile device so your trips will register for the price cap. You can get a receipt later from the ticket portal here: <u>https://nettilataus.turku.fi/nettilataus/emv.jsf</u>.

#### 5.1.1.1 From Kupittaa railway station to city centre

Bus: The easiest way to get to the city centre is to take the bus line 32 in the direction of Pansio, 42 in the direction of Perno, or 53 in the direction of Pikisaari. The buses stop to the city centre called Kauppatori. You can look up the schedule from *Kupittaan asema* to *Market Square Turku* using Föli's **journey planner**.

#### 5.1.1.2 From the Turku Harbour to city centre

Bus: You can get to the city centre from the harbour on bus line 1. You can look up the routes from the journey planner <u>here</u> using the locations from *Turku Satama* to *Market Square Turku*.

#### 5.1.1.3 From the bus station to the city centre

- On Foot: The bus station is almost in the city centre, so it is easy to take the trip on foot. Start by walking up Aninkaistenkatu to a square called Puutori. Turn right to Maariankatu and then turn left to Kauppiaskatu and you will find the Turku Market Square.
- By bus: If you want to take the bus, there are several buses that will go past the station area. You can look up the schedule and map <u>here</u> using locations from *linja-autoasema Turku* to Market Square Turku.

## Fölläri city bikes

Turku has a city bike system that is very easy and affordable. You can rent the bikes using an app by Donkey Republic. Also, you can use the shared e-cargo bikes through the same app. More information and instructions <u>here</u>.

## Hotels

**Scandic Hotels** offer a discount from the prices of the day with a code **FIARB**. The code works for all Scandic hotels in Turku. Guests can choose their preferred room type and receive an additional discount when paying for the reservation





immediately upon booking. The rooms can be booked according to the hotel's booking status.
